

## **2006 CALIFORNIA YOUNG LAWYERS ASSOCIATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION SCHEDULE**

Five seats on the State Bar of California's 15 member California Young Lawyers Association (CYLA) Board of Directors are up for election during 2006. Districts 1, 3, 5, 7, and 9 will each have one open seat.

- District 1:** Butte, Colusa, Del Norte, Glenn, Humboldt, Lake, Lassen, Mendocino, Modoc, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, Shasta, Sierra, Siskiyou, Sutter, Tehama, Trinity and Yuba counties
  
- District 3:** Alameda, Contra Costa, San Mateo and Santa Clara counties
  
- District 5:** Fresno, Inyo, Kern, Kings, Madera, Mariposa, Merced, Mono, Monterey, San Benito, San Joaquin, Santa Cruz, Stanislaus and Tulare counties
  
- District 7:** Los Angeles County
  
- District 9:** Imperial and San Diego counties

Any member of the CYLA who will not have reached the age of thirty-five years on or before December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year in which elected, or who will not have entered his or her fourth year in practice in California on or before December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year in which elected, shall be eligible for election as a Director from the State Bar District within which he or she maintains his or her principal place of business. Lawyer members are elected for three-year terms and will assume their offices at the conclusion of 2006 Annual Meeting.

**The 2006 schedule of dates and deadlines is:**

- February 1                      Nomination petitions available
  
- April 3                              Last day to file nominating petitions
  
- April 20\*                        Eligibility list closes
  
- May 1                                Ballots mailed
  
- June 30                            Last day for voting
  
- July 10 – 13                    Canvass of ballots
  
- October 5 – 8                  Annual Meeting – Monterey, Swearing-in Ceremony

\* Any active member of the State Bar and the California Young Lawyers Association, in good standing on the date the eligibility list closes, whose principal place of business is located within a county that is included within the State Bar district in which there is an election, shall be eligible to vote in the 2006 election.
